Summary

In Spring 2020, BESTMAP conducted a series of interviews with farmers in the five case study areas. This task is described in detail in Deliverable 3.4 (Summaries of data, obstacles and challenges from interview campaigns).

Whilst the majority of interviews were conducted in person as initially planned, the onset of the Covid-19 crisis necessitated some case studies conducting a portion of their interviews over the telephone to ensure sufficient sample size.

This deliverable describes the collection, processing, anonymisation and storage of the transcriptions of the farmer interviews conducted by the project.

Each case study provided a short report on each interview, plus an overall CS summary report on their interview campaign. These reports, and the process of their qualitative analysis, are described in D3.4.
